EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 98

WHEREAS, Patrolman Christopher Reeves has been a member of the City of Millville Police Department since 2004; and

WHEREAS, Patrolman Reeves graduated from Millville Senior High School in 1991, served in the United States Marine Corps, then graduated from the Vineland Police Academy in 2004; and

WHEREAS, Patrolman Reeves was loving and devoted son, husband, and father; and

WHEREAS, Patrolman Reeves tragically lost his life in the line of duty; and

WHEREAS, Patrolman Reeves' selfless devotion to public service and the protection of others makes him a hero and a true role model for all New Jerseyans; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate and fitting for the State of New Jersey to recognize his true commitment to the welfare and safety of others, to mark his untimely passing, to honor his memory, and to remember his family, friends and fellow police officers as they mourn their tragic loss;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, KIMBERLY M. GUADAGNO, Acting Governor of the State of New Jersey, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and by the Statutes of this State, do hereby ORDER and DIRECT:

1. The flag of the United States of America and the flag of New Jersey shall be flown at half-staff at all State departments, offices, agencies and instrumentalities during appropriate hours on Friday, July 13, 2012, in recognition of the life and in mourning of the passing of Patrolman Christopher Reeves.

2. This Order shall take effect immediately.
